Chemical Name: Bleach 6%

Task: Disinfecting and sanitising with bleach

Description: Heavy duty disinfectant and sanitiser for floors and other surfaces.

Cleaning Procedure:

Floor Mopping

Floors in kitchens & bathrooms:

1. Add 500ml of water to 10 litres of water in a bucket.
2. Using gloves, wash walls and floors with mop.
3. Wait 10 minutes, then rinse clean.

Toilet Bowl Cleaning

1. Pour 250ml into toilet bowl and flush.

Soaking

Whitening clothes & cleaning nappies:

1. Add 250ml per load before immersing the articles.
2. Pre-soak for 15 minutes before washing.

Benefits:

- Universal bleach for many surfaces

Product Sizes:

- 5L
- 20L

Precautions

- Avoid skin and eye contact and breathing in vapour, mists and aerosols.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Avoid skin and eye contact; use overalls, chemical goggles, face shield, elbow-length impervious gloves, splash apron or equivalent chemical impervious outer garment, and rubber boots when handling.
- Ensure proper ventilation during use.
- Please DO NOT pour Bleach directly onto clothes, make sure you dilute the liquid before adding the clothes.
- DO NOT use on Wool.

Hazards

- This product is hazardous while handling and classified as dangerous goods for transport.
- Swallowing can result in nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, abdominal pain and chemical burns to the gastrointestinal tract.
- A severe eye irritant. Corrosive to eyes; contact can cause corneal burns. Contamination of eyes can result in permanent injury.
