

Safe Operating Procedures

H44 Chlorinated Detergent

Suitable for use in kitchens and food preparation areas.

Task

Heavy Duty Bathroom Cleaning

Chemical

H44 Chlorinated Detergent

Procedure

1. Position a 'Cleaning In Progress' sign outside the bathroom door.
2. Apply H44 to the bowls and urinals and allow product to stand whilst the remainder of the bathroom is being cleaned.
3. High dust: see Safe Operating Procedures for Bathroom Cleaning & Sanitising.
4. Clean light fixtures: see Safe Operating Procedures for Bathroom Cleaning & Sanitising.
5. Clean mirrors: see Safe Operating Procedures for Glass & Mirror Cleaning.
6. Clean wash basins: wipe down wash basins using a clean cloth and H44.
7. Spot clean and disinfect walls, partitions, dispensers & shelves (if present): apply H44 to the surface or to a dampened cloth and wipe over.
8. Clean toilet bowls & urinals: scrub down internal bowl with brush and wipe over external with H44 and a dampened cloth. Discard cloth after use.
9. Pick up rubbish: pick up loose paper towel and other rubbish from the floor. Sweep floor and pick up rubbish with a dustpan & brush.
10. Clear floor of all obstacles: remove all supplies and equipment and move rubbish receptacles.
11. Mop floor: see Safe Operating Procedures for General Area Floor Mopping.
12. Return to service: replace all rubbish receptacles, remove the "Cleaning in Progress" sign.
13. Clean up: wash and rinse all buckets & wringers, stand/hang them up to dry. Wipe down other equipment with a disinfectant and clean wipe or rinse with clean water.



⚠ Precautions

- Strategically place "Wet Floor" signs or "Cleaning in Progress" signs.
- Wear gloves when handling chemicals.
- Wear appropriate footwear to prevent slipping.
- Always wash hands before and after handling chemicals.
- Always read SDS & labels before using chemical product.

☠ Hazards

- Wet tiled areas can be slippery.
- Will cause irritation to mouth, throat and stomach with effects including mucous build-up, irritation to the tongue and lips and pains in the stomach, which may lead to nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.
- Will cause irritation to the eyes with effects including: tearing, pain, and temporary blurred vision.
- Will cause irritation to the skin, with effects including; redness, itching and drying/defatting.
- Mists from the product will cause irritation to the nose, throat and respiratory system with effects including; coughing, discomfort, breathing difficulty and shortness of breath.
- Prolonged or repeated skin contact may lead to dermatitis.
